\$10. supplies and material fee is to be paid to the instructor the first session.

Supplies are to be provided by the instructor during class time.

The Supply cost includes the use of Carol's personal Calligraphy tools of pens, papers, watercolor paints and brushes.

Her favorite ink cartridge Calligraphy pen is the Pilot

Parallel Pen offered in several different nib sizes. For learning I recommend the 2.4 nib size as a great place to start. The other available nib sizes will be offered for trial use during class time only.

The idea of working with the tools offered in the market place is for you to find the pens, pencils, and brushes that you are able to bond with to create fantastic lettering artwork that resonates with You.

Other items included in the \$10. supply fee are practice papers, speciality papers, and other items the instructor feels will enhance your lettering experience.

Supplies Students are Required to Bring to Class:

- Calligraphy pen: The Pilot Parallel Pen 2.4mm nib size
- I will be sharing the other nib sizes offered during class time.
- Several ink cartridges - black is preferred.
- 2 Sharp tip pencils for drawing larger letters and guide lines.
- NO Paper is necessary - that is to be provided by the instructor

The Pilot Parallel Pen nib size 2.4mm and ink cartridges is able to be purchased at Nevada Fine Arts, Reno and on-line. Costing roughly under \$15.

A Calligraphy Lettering booklet written and illustrated by the Instructor is included in the class tuition fee.
