Class material: Set of crochet hooks (steel hooks) (sizes: 4 to 9), one skein of worsted weight yarn in color of your choice, size between 6-8 (acrylic), yarn needle (tapestry needle), stitch markers, scissors, pen and paper, and your tablet or laptop.

Day 1. Students will:

- learn how to read yarn labels, different types of yarns, and crochet hooks.
- Learn how to hold a crochet hook, crochet a chain, and single crochet stitch.

- Begin working on their first, single crochet, beginner project: a scarf or a chunky blanket.

Day 3. Students will

- learn the double crochet stitch and the half double crochet stitch
- Continue working on their scarf project using single crochet, half double crochet stitch and the double crochet stitch.

- learn how the Triple (or Treble) Crochet stitch.
- Continue working on their scarf project using single crochet, half double crochet stitch the double crochet stitch, and the triple crochet stitch.
